



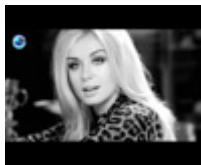

### ALISON BALSOM 'CAPRICE IN A MINOR'



Alison Balsom is a British trumpet soloist who studied at the Guildhall School of Music and Drama, the Royal Scottish Academy of Music & the Paris Conservatoire. Named 'Female Artist of the Year' at the 2009 Classical BRIT Awards, Alison has released a string of successful albums with EMI Classics, including Caprice featuring Nicolo Paganini's 'Caprice in A Minor'.

### KATHERINE JENKINS 'BRING ME TO LIFE'



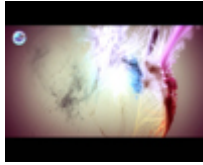
Katherine Jenkins is a Welsh singer & the fastest selling female mezzo-soprano since Maria Callas. A former school teacher, she signed the biggest recording deal in UK classical music history & has released a staggering seven albums before the age of thirty. This Autumn Katherine released her most ambitious album to date, 'Believe', a mix of contemporary & traditional repertoire produced by David Foster for Warner Records.

### ROMEO & JULIET 'MAIN LOVE THEME'



Critically acclaimed Dutch violinist Andre Rieu performs the main love theme to Franco Zeffirelli's 1968 film adaptation of William Shakespeare's Romeo & Juliet. Starring British actor Leonard Whiting & Argentine actress Olivia Hussey, the film received thirteen Award nominations including two Oscars, and a BAFTA for Italian composer Nino Rota who wrote the film's now much coveted score.

## OLAFUR ARNALDS 'LJOSIO'



Ólafur Arnalds is Iceland's latest neo-classical export & bright new talent. Steadily gaining international recognition since his 2007 debut 'Eulogy for Evolution', Ólafur's near weightless orchestral pieces are a contemporary mix of chamber strings, piano & discreet electronics. His second album 'Found Songs' is a modern release that awakens memories of a tradition lost in the digital age we live in.

## PORTISHEAD 'GLORYBOX'



Formed in 1991 by keyboardist / multi-instrumentalist Geoff Barrow & singer Beth Gibbons, Portishead have been cited as one of the most influential bands to come out of the United Kingdom. Appearing at the Roseland Theatre for their first live gig in New York, Portishead perform 'Glorybox' with the New York Philharmonic Orchestra and five-piece horn ensemble in what is now considered one of their most memorable concerts.

German born musician Hanz Zimmer is one of Hollywood's most innovative & prolific film composers. He achieved international recognition in 1988 for his score to Barry Levinson's Rain Man & has since received Oscar, Grammy & Golden Globe awards for scores to Gladiator, Pearl Harbour, Black Hawk Down & Pirates of the Caribbean.
