BLAKE & CAMILLA KERSLAKE 'NESSUN DORMA'



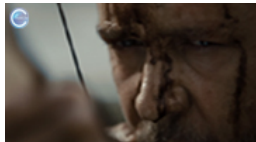
Performing live at the Classical Brit Awards 2010, British soprano Camilla Kerlake & classical crossover group Blake perform Howard Goodall's spectacular interpretation of Puccini's 'Nessun Dorma', widely recognised as one of the greatest sporting anthems of all time. This unique collaboration marks the start of the 2010 World Cup in South Africa and the 20th anniversary of the celebrated performance by The Three Tenors.

THE FIVE BROWNS 'RHAPSODY ON A THEME FOR PAGANINI'



American classical pianists The 5 Browns perform an arrangement of Sergei Rachmaninoff's Rhapsody on a Theme of Paganini in A Minor. The first set of five siblings to enter the Juilliard Conservatory New York, Desirae, Deondra, Gregory, Melody & Ryan Brown from Houston, Texas have released 4 successful albums & are taking the world by storm with their inventive interpretations of classical standards.

ROBIN HOOD 'FATE HAS SMILED UPON US'



In one of the most anticipated films of 2010 Oscar winner Russell Crowe stars as Robin Hood in a modern adaptation by director Ridley Scott chronicling the life of Hood from expert archer in the service of King Richard to unlikely hero in 13th century Nottingham. German composer Marc Streitenfeld, who collaborated with Ridley on 'American Gangster', provides the film's striking musical score.

BOWERBIRDS 'NORTHERN LIGHTS'



American folk group The Bowerbirds appear in a video for Northern Lights from their second album 'Upper Air' with Canadian label Dead Oceans. Based in North Carolina The Bowerbirds principle songwriters Beth Tacular & Phil Moore follow their debut album with a personal set of songs, sparsely backed by acoustic guitars, upright bass, organ, piano & autoharp.

KATIE MELUA 'THE FLOOD'



Katie Melua is a Georgian-British singer, songwriter & musician. One of Britain's most successful artists of the past decade Melua is an exclusive recording artist with Dramatico under the management of musician/songwriter Mike Batt. Her long long-awaited fourth studio album The House, produced by William Orbit, heralds a new phase in Melua's musical career & features songs written by Melua, Guy Chambers & Lauren Christy.

C MUSIC TV CLOSE UP - SARAH CHANG 'BRUCH BRAHMS VIOLIN CONCERTOS'



Internationally recognised as one of the most captivating and gifted artists in classical music, Korean American violin virtuoso Sarah Chang began her studies aged 4 & was promptly enrolled in the Juilliard School of Music. She has since released a string of hugely successful albums with EMI Classics, appeared on television & radio programmes worldwide & performed with internationally with the world's leading orchestras.

Chang talks to C Music TV about her most recent recording of Brahms Violin Concerto No.1 and Bruch Violin Concerto No. 1 with Kurt Masur & the Dresden Philharmonic Orchestra. Described as "gloriously played and refulgently engineered" Bruch's concertos was one of the first Chang played aged five.
