EMMA JOHNSON - FLIGHT OF THE BUMBLEBEE



One of only a handful of clarinetists to have established herself as an international soloist, Emma Johnson is active recitalist, chamber musician & award-winning recording artist. Her debut album 'Voyage', featuring Rimsky-Korsakov's 'Flight of the Bumblebee', is a collection of modern classical pieces & jazz-inspired performances recorded with the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra.

WILD - HIPNOTIC



Wild are a five-piece classical group comprising of members Izzy Johnston (violin), Katie Fenner (violin), Chantal Leverton (viola), Iva Cojic (piano) & Andjelka Ristic (keyboards). Often compared to Bond thanks to a similar musical style & appearance, Wild's debut features three original pieces by composer Eric Serra (Big Blue & the Fifth Element) & arrangements by Tonjic Huljic (Maksim) & Jeff Knifely (Snow Petrol).

GLADIATOR 'NOW WE ARE FREE'



'Gladiator' (2000) is the five time Academy Award winning film from British director Ridley Scott. Featuring star performances from Russell Crowe & Joaquin Phoenix it is considered an unparalleled combination of vivid action & extraordinary storytelling. German composer Hans Zimmer provides a traditional heroic orchestral score in dark & ominous tones with ethereal vocals by Australian singer Lisa Gerrard.

EROICA TRIO - BEETHOVEN'S TRIPLE CONCERTO



Eroica are an American trio consisting of Julliard trained musicians Erika Nickrenz (piano), Susie Park (violin) and Sara Sant'Ambrogio (Cello). Taking their name from Beethoven's 'Eroica Symphony', Eroica have released six recordings with Angel/EMI & received multiple Grammy Award nominations. The video for Beethoven's Triple Concerto, from the album of the same name, was filmed while the group were on tour in America.

GHOSTLAND - INTERVIEW WITH AN ANGEL



Ghostland is an artistic collaboration between producer John Reynolds & musicians Caroline Dale & Justin Adams. Collectively John, Caroline & Justin have worked with Oasis, Brian Eno, Peter Gabriel & Björk while Caroline has also been involved in the biopic 'Hillary & Jackie' (1998) about cellist Jacqueline du Pré. Ghostland's acclaimed debut album 'Interview with the Angel' was released in 2001 on Instant Karma records.

Born in Buenos Aires in 1973, Argentine pianist Ingrid Fliter is recitalist, international soloist & one of only five pianists worldwide to have received the Gilmore Artist Award honouring profound musicianship.

An exclusive recording artist for EMI, Fliter has released two albums of works by Polish composer Frederic Chopin. Talking to C Music TV about her second album 'Chopin: Complete Waltzes', which has been described as '*a marvel of the most refined fluency & affection*' Fliter explains her love of Chopin's work & how she hopes the disc will offer a freshness to Chopin's evocative & well known repertoire.
